A Level Progress Score The Progress Score column shows how much progress students made between the end of Key Stage 4 and the end of their A Level studies compared to similar students across England. A score above zero means students made *more* progress, on average, than students across England who achieved similar results at the end of Key Stage 4.

Average result This tells you the average grade and average points that students achieved per A Level entry. The performance tables give a points value to all qualifications in order to compare qualifications of a different level, size and grading system.
