Summer 2023 exams timetable – IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS/CARERS

Second-year students and their parents/carers should take careful note of the finalised [Summer 2023 exams timetable](#) which has been published on our website.

Whilst this information will be of primary interest to our A2s, there will also be exams for **first-year students** studying Core Maths, Health and Social Care, and Medical Science.

The dates and times of these exams are set nationally by the exam boards, so students must attend on the specified dates and times. The College cannot move or reschedule exams, unless a student has an exams clash. Any clash will be identified by our Exams Office and students will be emailed individually about this after the February half-term, once all the exam entries have been made.

The exam boards expect all students to be available throughout the exam period, up to and including **Wednesday, 28 June 2023**. In exceptional circumstances, the boards reserve the right to move exams within this period.

Individual exam timetables will be available on CEDAR before the Easter holiday. Students will be notified when these are available.

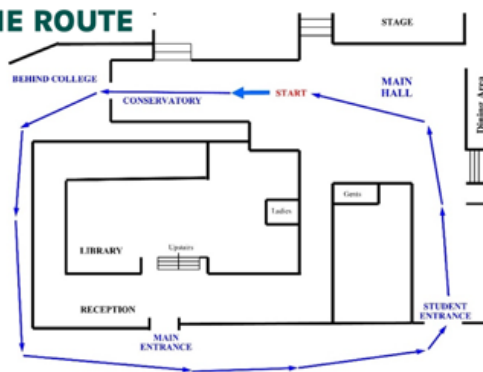

Appendix: fire evacuation routes and muster points

Main Building – evacuate via the main entrance doors, turn right, walk through the smaller top car park and muster in the **rear main car park**. (Staff/students in rooms M6-M10, M25-M26 and Systems Support may leave via the fire exit opposite M10 and muster in the **rear main car park**.)

Main Hall and Study Area – evacuate via the fire door at the foot of the green Conway stairs and muster in the **rear main car park**.

Conway Building – evacuate via the rear staircase fire exit and muster in the **rear main car park**. (Staff/students in the Tutor corridor may leave via the fire exit nearest the Study Centre and muster in the **rear main car park**.)

Cooksey Building – evacuate via the rear staircase, through the fire exit below the Dawson staircase and then out via the Park Gate. Turn left and muster in the **rear main car park**.

Dawson Building – evacuate via the rear staircase and through the fire exit nearest the Park Gate. Turn left out of the Park Gate and muster in the **rear main car park**.

Kitchen – evacuate via the fire exit. Turn left out of the Park Gate and muster in the **rear main car park**.

Park Building (Drama) – evacuate via the fire exit nearest the rear of the shop. Turn left out of the Park Gate and walk up to the **rear main car park**.

Park Building (Sports Hall) – evacuate via the fire exit at the foot of the rear staircase. Turn left out of the Park Gate and walk up to the **rear main car park**.

Park Building (Music and PE) – evacuate via the fire exit nearest P7. Turn left out of the Park Gate and walk up to the **rear main car park**.

Science Building (S8, S9, S10) – go down the stairs, turn right, walk through Park Building and evacuate via the fire exit nearest the Sports Hall rear staircase. Turn left out of the Park Gate and walk up to the **rear main car park**.

Science Building (S1, S2, S5, S6, S7, reprographics, staff room) – evacuate via the fire exit opposite S2. Turn left and proceed to Park Gate. Turn right and muster along the **pavement on Park Drive South**. Walk down as far as possible to ensure students can congregate on the pavement but do not walk across to Greenhead Park.

Science Building (S3, S4) – evacuate via the fire exit in this room. Turn left and proceed to Park Gate. Turn right and muster along the **pavement on Park Drive South**. Walk down as far as possible to ensure students can congregate on the pavement but do not walk across to Greenhead Park.

Science Building (Floors 2 & 3) – evacuate via the rear stairs and by the fire exit. Turn left and proceed to Park Gate. Turn right and muster along the **pavement on Park Drive South**. Walk down as far as possible to ensure students can congregate on the pavement but do not walk across to Greenhead Park.

Rostron Building – evacuate out rear of the building and muster on the **pavement on Greenhead Road and Park Avenue** but do not congregate on the grassy area on the other side of the road.
