

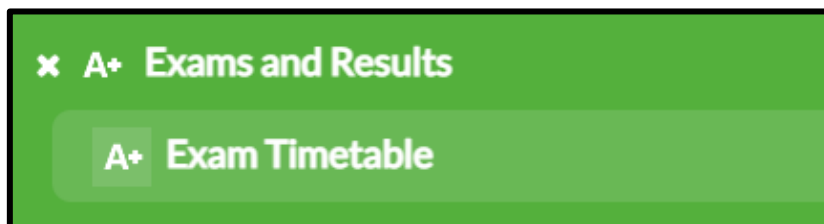


Dear all,
