Summer Academy

Leeds Conservatoire Summer Academy

We're delighted to announce that bookings are now open for our exciting, week-long <u>Summer Academy</u> summer school.

Summer Academy is a summer school for students starting Year 13 in September 2024, and runs from **Monday**29 July – Friday 2 August 2024. There are two strands for students to choose from: Performance and
Production. Each of these strands will include a series of classes, practical workshops and masterclasses with
experienced lecturers and industry professionals. It is a fantastic opportunity for students to experience a taste of
conservatoire education whilst building confidence, skills and meeting friendly, like-minded creative people.

Students who complete the Summer Academy and go on to successfully apply to an undergraduate course at Leeds Conservatoire will receive a reduction of 8 UCAS tariff points in the UCAS tariff points required for entry.

For students further afield, there is a four-night residential option at nearby student accommodation, <u>Clarence Dock Village</u>. There will also be a programme of evening social activities throughout the week, which will encourage students to relax after each busy day and to get to know their fellow summer school peers.

Subject Spotlight - Public Health & Community Wellbeing

Assistant Professor Andrew Hart

Public health is the science and art of preventing disease, prolonging life and promoting health. We are facing an increase in many preventable illnesses and there is an urgent need to tackle them. The BSC (Hons) Public Health and Community Wellbeing is a programme that equips students with the skills and understanding to make a positive difference to the health and quality of life of people and their communities. The programme includes a work placement and students have the opportunity to work alongside experts in the field and develop their own area of specialism. The programme pays particular focus to employability supporting students to think and work on employability starting from the day of induction into the course through to the last year of study.

Recent graduates of the programme have been successful in gaining jobs such as: health advisor; project worker (drugs and alcohol); homeless support worker; hostel manager; antenatal inclusion worker; public health officer (local authority); CEO of a housing organisation.

Other graduates have gone on to study at postgraduate level: MA Social Work; MSc Psychology; PGCE (teacher training); MSc Public Health; PhD.

The programme is taught by a team of health experts with research and teaching experience in areas including public health, epidemiology, social work, sociology, and psychology. The academic team includes active researchers and students have the opportunity to be involved in some of this research. Examples of current research projects include children's screen time, sleep, and physical activity; pre-eclampsia and eclampsia; maternal health issues; Born in Bradford; domestic violence; long term health conditions; mental health and wellbeing; smoking cessation; substance misuse; leisure services; contraceptive use; fertility awareness.

What is a Risk Manager?

The world is a risky place with dangers and hazards everywhere, in this profession you would be identifying and assessing threats and putting plans in place for if things go wrong.

Areas of risk management

- Business continuity
- Commodity (buying and selling)
- Corporate governance
- Enterprise risk
- Environmental risk
- Financial risk
- Information and security
- Insurance, market and credit risk
- Regulatory and operational risk
- Technology risk

Some common responsibilities

- Plan, design and implement processes
- Evaluating risk against costs, legal requirements, environmental factors
- Reviewing risk policies and conducting audits of policy and compliance
- Reporting risk in an appropriate way for different audiences
- Establishing the level of risk organisations are prepared to accept
- Provide support, education and training to staff

Specific tasks will vary considerably depending on the area you work in and how specialized your role is

What Skills do you need

- Analytical thinking, thorough and a good eye for detail
- Excellent verbal communication, interpersonal and presentation skills
- Persistence and motivation
- Resilience and the ability to work under pressure
- Technical, numerical and commercial acumen
- The ability to think on your feet and work proactively to suggest change and improvement

What to do to get into this career

2-3 A Levels leading to a relevant degree course.
